OPEN DAY ARRANGEMENTS - 2010

The annual Open Day at Wanganui High School will take place on **Thursday 17 June.**

The main purpose of Open Day is to give 2010 Year 8 students and their caregivers, the opportunity to see the school's facilities and the programmes offered to students.

Two sessions will be run during Open Day: 4 pm to 6 pm, and 7 pm to 9 pm.
